State of IT Automation

By 2025

- 70% of organizations will complement continuous delivery of applications with continuous infrastructure automation to improve business agility, a significant increase from fewer than 20% in 2021
- 70% of organizations will implement structured infrastructure automation to deliver flexibility and efficiency, a significant increase from 20% in 2021
- 25% of enterprises will automate more than half of their network activities, an increase from fewer than 8% of enterprises in 2022
